



Railroad Park Dog Park FACILITY GUIDELINES

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Dog Park users are expected to demonstrate respect for public property and the rights of other users through adherence to the following guidelines.

FACILITY-SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

1. Dog Park Hours will be from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. November 1 through February 28 and 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. March 1 through October 31 and will close without prior notice when wet, icy or other hazardous conditions exist.
2. Dogs must display current rabies vaccination tags.
3. Dogs belonging to Lewisville residents must display city license tags issued by Animal Services.
4. Dogs to remain on-leash while entering and exiting the double-gated entry area.
5. Dogs must be kept off-leash while in the Dog Park.
6. Owners are to stay within the park and within view of their dogs.
7. Dogs shall be under the voice control of their owners at all times.
8. Any dog exhibiting aggressive behavior must be removed immediately. Owners should utilize good judgment by not bringing dogs with aggressive personalities to park.
9. Spike or pinch collars are not allowed in the park.
10. Owners are liable for damage or injury inflicted by their dogs.
11. Owners must have a visible leash at all times.
12. Owners are responsible for removal and disposal of feces of their pets.
13. All children 9-15 years of age must be under strict adult supervision.
14. Children under 9 years of age are not allowed in the Dog Park.
15. Children are not allowed to run with or chase after dogs in the Dog Park.
16. No puppies under 4 months of age.
17. No more than two (2) dogs per adult.
18. Dogs in heat are not allowed.
19. Park users and dog owners assume all risk related to dog park use.
20. Small dog area is for dogs less than 30 lbs. only. Small dogs may play in the large dog area at their own risk, but it is not recommended.
21. Owners shall repair any damage done by their dog (i.e., holes dug by the dog).
22. No glass containers, food, drink (except plastic bottled water), tobacco, or alcohol products allowed in the Dog Park.
23. Violators maybe subject to removal from the park and suspension of park privileges.
24. Owners release and discharge the City of Lewisville from liability for any injury or damage caused to or by pets during any time while using the park. If a dog bite to a human should occur it must be reported to Animal Services – 972-219- 3478.

25. Dogs are prohibited in or on field areas and associated bleachers.
