



Lake Park Campgrounds

FACILITY GUIDELINES

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Lewisville Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) is responsible for coordinating the activities of these facilities. The City will lease facilities without consideration of group affiliation or meeting content. Admission and money-making activities are not permitted without approval from the City Council.

RESERVATIONS:

Reservation Methods: Reservations may be made in-person at the Campground located at 1900 Kingfisher Drive, Lewisville, TX, 75057 or by telephone, (972)219-3742.

Advance Reservations: Reservations may be made up to 90 days in advance, unless an alternate time limit has been established.

Standing Reservations: Standing reservations are not allowed at this facility.

Reservation Requirements: A two-day reservation is required on all holiday weekends.

RENTAL/USE FEES:

Site fee (per day) as specified in the fee ordinance, Sec. 2.201. Park entrance fees are also applicable.

FACILITY-SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

1. The campground is for camping only and sites may not be rented for picnics.
2. Sites are rented to adults 18 years of age and older. Persons under 18 years of age may stay overnight only if they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian or with his/her written permission and under the supervision of a responsible adult that rented the site.

3. Occupancy of camping facilities is limited to 14 days in any 30-day period, unless an alternate time limit has been established.
4. Site assignments will be established by the campground staff based on the camping unit type and size.
 - A tent will not be placed in sites 2 thru 79.
 - Sites 59 thru 79 are generally for units greater than 30 feet long and with 50-amp service requirement.
5. A specific site may be requested, and every effort will be made to honor that request if the site is available for the duration of the reservation and the camping unit meets the established guidelines for the site. No reservation is guaranteed for a specific site.
6. Campsite occupancies are limited to two (2) vehicles and six (6) people, unless prior approval is obtained.
7. Campers shall not sleep outside of a camper, tent, or other camping unit designed for overnight sleeping accommodations.
8. Extra vehicles, boats, private watercraft, etc. that cannot be parked in the area provided at the rented campsite must be parked in the overflow parking area.
9. Campsites must be kept clean. Items including but not limited to boats and vehicles may not be kept in a campsite the renting party has not rented. A vehicle or other property that is unattended or abandoned and creating a hazardous or unsafe condition, or in an unauthorized place is subject to removal or impoundment.
10. Fires are permitted only in fire rings and grills provided at each site. Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
11. Black water and grey water may be disposed of only at the dump station.
12. Faulty utility hook-ups are not permitted (car wires, leaking hose, etc.) and service will be disconnected.
13. Loud voices, music and other noise are not permitted between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
14. Pets must remain on a 6-foot leash and may not be left unattended outside of the camper unit. Pets are not permitted in public buildings unless they are assisting disabled persons.
15. Campers may not perform any mechanical work or wash any auto/RV without prior approval.
16. Horse/RV combination trailers with horses or livestock are not permitted.
17. Semi tractor-trailer combinations and semi-tractor cabs are not permitted.
18. Campers may not leave any camping unit unattended for more than 24 hours without prior approval.
19. The campground security gates are closed from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Persons not renting a camping unit are not authorized to enter the campground during these hours.
20. If you need to leave the campground before your reservation has ended, you may contact the campground staff to request a credit for the time remaining on your reservation. This is not applicable to campers who have been asked to leave as a result of violating campground policies.
21. By 1:00 p.m., campground users must check-out or make arrangements with the park attendant to extend their stay. Unless permission had been obtained, users will be charged for another day if not checked out by 1:00 p.m.

22. Campers violating these policies may be requested to vacate the campground and will not be granted any refunds.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Campground office hours are from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

FEES:

1. The City of Lewisville fee ordinance contains all fees related to the Campgrounds.
