



Railroad Park Dog Park FACILITY GUIDELINES

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Dog users are expected to demonstrate respect for public property and the rights of other users through adherence to the following guidelines.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

8 AM – 11 PM

Park is closed every Thursday for maintenance

FACILITY-SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

1. Dogs must display current rabies vaccination and registration tags.
2. Dogs to remain on-leash while entering and exiting the double-gated entry area.
3. Dogs must be kept off-leash while in the Dog Park.
4. Dogs shall be under the voice control of their owners at all times.
5. Any dog exhibiting aggressive behavior must be removed immediately. Owners should utilize good judgement by not bringing dogs with aggressive personalities to park.
6. Spike or pinch collars are not allowed in the park.
7. Owners are liable for damage or injury inflicted by their dogs.
8. Owners must have a visible leash at all times.
9. Owners are responsible for removal and disposal of feces of their pets.
10. All children must be under strict adult supervision.
11. No puppies under four (4) months of age.
12. Dogs in heat are not allowed.
13. Park users and dog owners assume all risk related to dog park use.
14. Small dog area is for dogs less than 30 lbs. only. Small dogs may play in the large dog area at their own risk, but it is not recommended.
15. Owners shall repair any damage done by their dog (i.e., holes dug by the dog).
16. No glass containers, food, drink (except plastic bottled water), tobacco, or alcohol products allowed.
17. Violators may be subject to removal from the park and suspension of park privileges.

18. Owner's release and discharge the City of Lewisville from liability for any injury or damage caused to or by pets during any time while using the park. If a dog bite to a human should occur is must be reported to Animal Services 972-219-3478.
